

 - China recognizes this too: NTGPR
- China lacks long term "plan", has "interests"
 - mostly local; int'l interests: mixed bag
- Action/reaction cycles or spirals remain a major concern




Specific Concerns

 - SCS, ECS
- Chinese Nationalism
 - Domestic Legitimacy, Role of Taiwan, Internet
- PLA better able to secure those interests
 - primarily the local ones

Budgets: a good indicator of intentions, dangers


Chinese Official Military Spending










